Age Requirement:

Contest is open to youth ages 13-18

The Work Must Be Original:

You must be the creator of the art and image file you submit to the competition. Your art must be your own original concept and not a copy of anyone else's material.

Permissions:

By entering this art competition, you are granting us permission to reproduce images of your artwork on our Teen Tech Week promo materials, website and in our newsletters. Artwork will not be used for any other purpose. Winning entries will be displayed in the Brantford Public Library space for a time period agreed upon between the library and artist.

File Formats:

The acceptable file formats are: jpg and png.

The Entry Process:

- Deadline Sunday, February 18, 2018.
- Winner will be contacted by February 26, 2018.

Judging Criteria:

Does the submitted artwork incorporate technology? Examples include: digital design, photo design or original artwork applied to digitally generated images.

Does the submitted artwork fit the theme of the competition?

Is there a creative interpretation of the subject/ theme?

Is the originality of the work interesting?
