


BiblioCommons 'Recently Returned' Feature

When you enable the Recently Returned feature, BiblioCommons keeps a list of all of the titles you have borrowed. Only items that you borrow after the feature is enabled are recorded. Only you can see your borrowing history. If you turn off tracking of recently returned items, the titles are removed.

To enable the Recently Returned feature:

- Login to your account
- Click on Settings at the top of the page
- Click on Privacy (on blue line)
- Check the box marked "Enable Recently Returned"
- Click on Save
